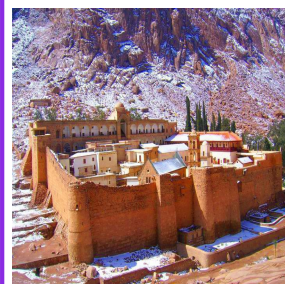
### **First Day :**Private trip to St Catherine Monastery from Sharm el Sheikh
