First Day :Discover Cairo from Soma bay

Marsaalamtours representative will pick you up from your hotel in Soma bay at 002:00 a.m to Cairo With Air Conditioning Vehicles. The Distance is about 560 km, It Takes 6 hours to **Cairo** where you will be met and assisted by our representative.

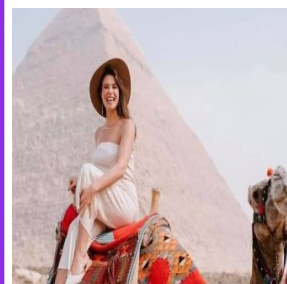
You will arrive in Giza at 8:30 am First, you will visit the Great Pyramid of Giza (also known as the Pyramid of Khufu or the Pyramid of [Cheops](#)) is the oldest and largest of the pyramids in the Giza pyramid complex. It is the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the only one to remain largely intact.



The great pyramid was built as a tomb for the Fourth Dynasty Egyptian pharaoh Khufu and estimate that it was built in the 26th century BC during a period of around 27 years.

Initially standing at 146.5 meters (481 feet), the Great Pyramid was the tallest man-made structure in the world for more than 3,800 years. Throughout history, the majority of the smooth white limestone casing was removed, which lowered the pyramid's height to the present 138.5 meters. What is seen today is the underlying core structure. The base was measured to be about 230.3 meters (755.6 ft) square, giving a volume of roughly 2.6 million cubic meters (92 million cubic feet), which includes an internal hillock

If you wish to visit the burial chamber of King [Cheops](#). It will cost (25 \$ per person)





Then we will visit the Pyramid of [Chephren](#) or Khafre. This is the second-tallest and second-largest of the 3 Ancient Egyptian [Pyramids of Giza](#) and the tomb of the Fourth-Dynasty pharaoh Khafre (Chefren), who ruled c. 2558?2532 BC



Then we will the Pyramid of Mykerinus.

We go head to visit the Valley Temple of king Chephren. While doing that you can have a closer look at the Great Sphinx - the legendary guardian that stands by the huge funeral complex with its lion body and the head of king Chephren. Enjoy a camel ride by the Pyramids of Giza in the desert

The Museum of Egyptian Antiquities in Tahir

It exhibits a rare collection of over 250,000 genuine artifacts that date as far back as 5000 years, including an exclusive exhibit dedicated to the Tutankhamen - A collection of treasures, gold, and jewelry that were buried in his tomb for over 3,500 years before they were discovered in 1920 when his tomb was excavated.



If you wish to visit the mummy's royal hall, where you will have the feeling of strolling down the [Valley of the Kings](#) where most of

these mummies were originally resting then ask your Tripguide to take you to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. It will cost 50 \$ Extra per person.



The New Grand Museum is not officially open yet. It will be opened officially by the end of 2024. But if you wish to visit it we offer limited tours to test site readiness and the visitor experience ahead of the official opening. Access is currently limited to the Grand Hall, commercial area, and exterior gardens. All other interior paces, including access to the galleries and collections, are restricted until the official opening. You can also add this to the Grand [Egyptian Museum](#). Now we reach the tour ends after about 8 hours you will be transferred to your hotel
