3:Visit the Alabast

Men making alabaster pots the same way they've been made for thousands of years.The handmade alabaster objects are almost always very thin, lighter in weight, waxy feeling with a matte finish (not shiny). Hand artisans can only achieve this thinness of the product, not machines. Its colors range from pure white to a rich creamy white, and sometimes streaked with various hues of warm, rusty reds. Always ask to have the pieces you are looking at held to a light to see the true natural beauty of the colors and patterns. It comes in various sizes and shapes of pots, vases, cups, bowls, sconces, ashtrays,



4 :Temple of Hatshepsut

Temple of Hatshepsut is one of the most beautiful & best preserved of all of the temples of Ancient Egypt you can find at Luxor. The temple was built on three levels with two wide ramps in a central position joining the levels together. Rising out of the desert Plain, in a series of terraces, The temple of Hatshepsut Mergs with sheer limestone Cliffs of the eastern face of the Theban Mountain as if Nature herself had built this Extraordinary monument.



5 :The Colossi Of Memnon

Colossi of Memnon are Two massive stone statues of king Amenhotep III are the only remains of a complete mortuary temple. The statues are made from blocks of quartzite sandstone which exist in Cairo then moved 700 KM to Luxor, The two statues Know as the Colossi of Memnon, Rising about 18 M from the plain, They are the remains of what once the largest complex on the west bank, Built by Amenhotep the Third. At around noon you will have lunch in a Local restaurant in Luxor, Then Visit The Temple of Karnak -the largest ancient religious site known anywhere in the world :

7 :Karnak temple

The Temple of Karnak is the largest ancient religious site known anywhere in the world , No site in Egypt is more impressive than Karnak. It is the largest temple complex ever built by man. It represents the combined achievement of many generations of ancient builders and Pharaohs. The Temple of Karnak is actually three main temples situated on 247 acres of land. At the end of the

8 :Visit the Papyrus Gallery

The word *papyrus* refers both to the writing support invented by the ancient Egyptians ,and the plant from which they made the first writing material. Individual sheets were formed by laying the strips side by side, first in one vertical layer, and then in a second horizontal layer. It is generally accepted that no adhesive was used,sheets were pressed together and then dried in the sun
